I/We agree to the following: hereby enters into a Compliance Agreement with the United States Dept. of Agriculture (USDA) and the West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA) under the provisions of the Emerald Ash Borer quarantine and agrees to ship regulated articles only as provided for on this Compliance Agreement. will ship regulated ash logs, lumber, stumps, branches, and chips interstate or intrastate from a quarantined area to a non-quarantined area only if the regulated article will move to a mill approved under an appropriate WVDA/USDA Compliance Agreement or under an appropriate cooperator's compliance agreement. October 1 – March 31: Shipments will be allowed. A limited permit must be present with each shipment. Shipments must proceed from origin to mill destination without stopping (except for refueling or traffic conditions). April 1 to September 30: No shipment of regulated materials under this compliance agreement. ensure that each shipment of regulated material is accompanied by a completed WVDA Limited Permit and will distribute copies of the WVDA Limited Permits as follows: Pink and Yellow: Attached to waybill or other documents accompanying shipment, to be surrendered to the consignee at destination. White: Retain for records. (White copies will be picked up by the WVDA in early April) The USDA and WVDA retain the right to conduct inspections of regulated articles, monitor inspection procedures, and examine shipment records at any time. Records must be maintained for at least 36 months. All document requests will be filled within 48 hours of the initial request. If fails to comply with the provisions of this Compliance Agreement and/or the Emerald Ash Borer Quarantine regulations, this Compliance Agreement will be canceled. In addition, violations of federal regulations, including any alteration, forgery or unauthorized use of Federal or State forms, are subject to criminal penalties with monetary fines in accordance with 18 USC, imprisonment for a period not to exceed one year, or both, or civil penalties of up to \$500,000 (7UCS s7734 (b)). The USDA/WVDA reserve the right to revise or cancel the Compliance Agreement at any time. This Compliance Agreement replaces and supersedes any other Compliance Agreements issued to by the WVDA or USDA for the handling of regulated articles described in box 3 above originating from a quarantined area. Compliance agreements are non-transferable. The establishment must notify the local USDA,APHIS,PPQ or WVDA office in the event that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The designated signatory individual in block 6 changes, The applicant/company physically relocates, The company name or ownership changes, or Any other event which may affect the handling of the regulated article occurs. Signing below will validate this agreement, which shall remain in effect for one year from date of signing, but may be revised as necessary or revoked for noncompliance.
