The mobile laboratory also qualifies as a "Biosecurity Level 3" facility, meaning workers can safely handle even the most dangerous pathogens, according to Roger Hanshaw, WVDA's laboratory technology expert. "The fume hoods in this piece of equipment constantly pull fresh air in and exhaust potentially contaminated air through high-tech filters," Hanshaw said. "There is also a shower facility so that workers can go through a decontamination protocol before exiting."

The laboratory includes its own on-board water supply, along with generators to meet its electrical needs, making it a completely stand-alone facility.

The semi-trailer was purchased with

\$250,000 in Homeland Security funding. The approximately \$290,000 in equipment housed in the mobile laboratory came from existing WVDA laboratories, much of which was also funded with Homeland Security dollars.
